## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**THE THEOLOGICAL FACULTY OF TRIVENETO**  
and  
**SAENGTHAM COLLEGE**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between the following parties:

The Theological Faculty of Triveneto, a higher education institution which is located at via del Seminario 7 - 35122 Padova, Italy, run by the local Bishops Conference Triveneto and represented by Prof. Andrea Toniolo who is the Preside (dean) of faculty of theology of Triveneto; hereinafter referred to as FTTR,

and

Saengtham College, a higher education institution administered by the Bishops Conference of Thailand that offers Philosophy and Religion, Theology, Moral Theology, Christian Studies, and English for Education, Religion, and Culture, is situated at 20 M 6 Tha Kham, Sam Phran, Nakhon Pathom, and is represented by its Rector, **Rev. Fr. Theeraphol Kobvithayakul**, hereinafter referred to as SC.

In the spirit of collaboration, compassion, and friendship and with common interest in cooperation, FTTR and SC enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote joint training, professional development, research, and cultural collaboration and agree as follows:

### 1. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1.1. Scope of collaboration and partnership shall be initiated by both institutions.

1.2. Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either institution and may include, but are not limited to:

- Joint lecture exchange;
- Joint international conferences/webinars;
- Joint research, or creative works activities;
- Faculty/ Student Development Programs
- Sharing or creation of educational materials and resources; and

1.3. Any specific activity developed under this MOU shall be detailed in a subsequent agreement, signed by each institution's authorized signatory, which will describe the scope of the proposed activity, intended outcomes, budget, and responsible departments or individuals.

1.4. All activities shall be subject to the availability of resources and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives.

## **2. DURATION AND EVALUATION**

2.1. This MOU shall be in effect on a period of Five (5) years from the last date of signature. Either party may request termination of this agreement, in writing, ninety (90) days prior to the proposed termination date. Any activities in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed in writing.

2.2. A joint evaluation of the MOU will be initiated by the designated representatives six (6) months prior to expiration date to ensure outcome-based implementation of the plans and programs being agreed upon. Following the evaluation, the MOU may be renewed and resigned for an additional 5 years period.

2.3. Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either party and approved by the authorized signatories.

## **3. NON-DISCRIMINATION**

The parties agree not to discriminate based on religion, race, creed, national or ethnic origin, age, political affiliation, sexual orientation, or disability.

## **4. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW**

The parties specifically intend to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations as they may be amended from time to time. If any part of this Agreement is determined to violate federal, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith revisions to any such provisions. If the parties fail to agree within a reasonable time to revisions required to bring the entire Agreement into compliance, either party may terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party.

The provisions of this Agreement are severable, and if any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will remain in full force and effect.

## 8. WAIVER

The waiver of any breach of any term of this Agreement does not waive any subsequent breach of that or another term of this Agreement.

## 9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties as to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior discussions, agreements and undertakings of every kind and nature between them, whether written or oral, with respect to such subject matter. This Agreement may subsequently be modified only by a written document executed by both parties.

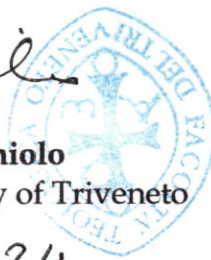

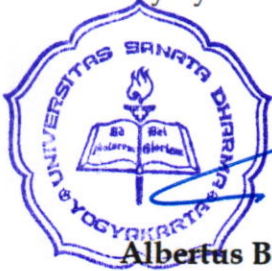


